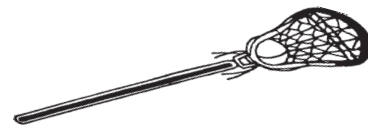

Ginny Martino is in her tenth season as the head coach of the women's lacrosse program at West Chester University. She has led WCU to the *NCAA Division II* title game in five out of the past six years, winning the *National Championship* in 2002.

Last season the Golden Rams posted a record-setting 18-3 overall mark and a 13-1 record in the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference. The Golden Rams won their 18th PSAC Championship crown overall and their sixth league title under Martino (1998-99, 2001-02, 2004-06). She was named the *PSAC Coach of the Year in 2005 and the NCAA II South Region Coach of the Year in 2005 and 2006*.

In 2001, Martino guided WCU to the *PSAC title* and an appearance in the NCAA II National Championship game. In recognition of her outstanding season, Martino was named the *2001 PSAC Coach of the Year*.

The Golden Rams also made consecutive appearances in the predominantly Division I National Lacrosse Championships in 1998 and 1999, while Martino was selected the *1998 Division II National Coach of the Year*.

A 1988 graduate of UMass, Martino was a four-year standout for the Minutewomen. She was also a member of the New England National Lacrosse Team from 1987-88.

Martino's career at UMass culminated in 1988 when she earned New England Regional Lacrosse and National Lacrosse All-Star Team honors. After graduation, Martino played lacrosse in Czechoslovakia for Team USA in 1989, the Philadelphia National Team in 1990-91, and the Central Region National Team in 1993.

The camps will offer individual instruction on fundamental skills in lacrosse, as well as competitive game experiences in a positive learning environment. REFUND POLICY

ELIGIBILITY

Ages for the WCU Lacrosse Camps are 8-17.

EQUIPMENT

West Chester University and its camp staff are not responsible for lost or missing items. **All personal equipment should be marked with the camper's name.**

Campers **MUST** bring sneakers, goggles, sticks, mouthguards, sunscreen and container of water (no glass). Day Campers may also bring cleats, swimsuit and towel. **Goalkeepers are encouraged to bring their own equipment.**

MEALS

Day Camp participants are responsible for providing their own lunch and drinks (in a cooler). Evening Camp participants should bring snacks and drinks.

FACILITIES

The **Day Camp** program will be conducted at WCU's Sturzebecker Health Sciences Center (South Campus) and its surrounding fields. These facilities include collegiate lacrosse fields, a new artificial surface field, pool, gymnasiums and classroom space. The **Evening Camp** will be conducted on the Multi-Purpose Athletic Turf Field behind the Sturzebecker Health Sciences Center.

RULES

Campers will be made aware of camp rules in a meeting on the first day of each session. Campers who violate these rules will be dismissed. Parents will be responsible for the cost of damages to camp property by their child. In case of dismissal, the camp fee will be prorated.

DIRECTIONS TO WCU

From Philadelphia & Delaware County

Take Route 3 West to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 South and exit at High Street. Follow High Street North to the second traffic light and make a left onto Rosedale Avenue. Follow Rosedale Avenue West to first traffic light and make a left onto New Street. Follow New Street South to John A. Farrell Football Stadium.

From Delaware & South

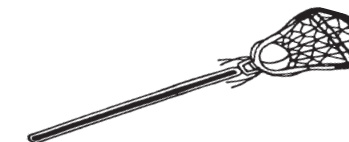
Take Route 202 North to Route 926 West. Turn left onto Route 926 West and go approximately one mile to New Street (first road). Make a right and follow New Street North to John A. Farrell Football Stadium.

From Exton, Downingtown & Coatesville

Take Route 30 East to Route 100 South to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 South and exit at High Street. Follow High Street North to the second traffic light and make a left onto Rosedale Avenue. Follow Rosedale Avenue West to first traffic light and make a left onto New Street. Follow New Street South to John A. Farrell Football Stadium.

From Southern Chester County

Take Route 1 to Route 52 North toward West Chester. Make a right onto Tighe Road, which is located just past Birmingham Road. Follow Tighe Road to New Street. Turn left onto New Street and follow North to John A. Farrell Football Stadium.
